Art Studio / Creativity Labs

Music and Dance Studio

SAAR is the only Curriculum Company in India to provide English Curriculum based on Synthetic Phonics. It's a skill - based learning with English taught with synthetic phonics approach, art integration & Maths taught with CPA approach. Visual Thinking strategy, songs and creativity act as the pivot for course conduction. It provides educational method which uses the Montessori method to develop a child's initiative and natural abilities. SAAR Education focuses on three age groups: 2-2.5 years, 2.5-6 years, and 6-12 years.





Use of Latest Technology

Digital Classrooms

Technology is appropriately used inside and outside the classroom at TISA. Teachers use boards as well as multimedia animated learning materials to make the teaching concept more interesting and comprehensive.

Computer Lab

The school also has a sophisticated computer laboratory. We have 60 personal computers apart from the various multimedia kits, laser and ink-jet printers, scanners, overhead projectors, broadband internet connectivity, etc.

It is mandatory for all classes to visit computer labs and practice their lessons to have a much better understanding and to develop their skills in using computers as well. We have regular teachers for teaching computer science to students along with lab assistants in each lab.

Wi-Fi Enabled E-School

The school has a state-of-the-art **ERP software** which assists us in school management programmes.

Our computer networking system has also made it easy for us to communicate important messages to parents via the **SMS server**. This makes it easy for us to reach the large parent community almost within no time in case of need.

We also have a **biometric system** of attendance for the staff.

Audio Visual Area

The Audio-Visual Room at our kindergarten is a vibrant and enchanting space designed to ignite the imagination and curiosity of our little learners. Adorned with colorful murals, soft furnishings, and interactive elements, this room is a haven where education and entertainment seamlessly blend.

School Cinema

Through School Cinema students at TISA learn to build a better relationship with their peer group and also learn to establish a better relationship with Parents and Teachers.

Students of various age groups watch movies that focus on value development. Additionally, parents & teachers of students up to grade V are also shown a selected movie to enhance their understanding & engagement.

Library

The school has a well-stocked and a spacious library and reading space for teachers and students with carefully selected books for every genre and reference books like dictionaries and encyclopedias.

Science Laboratories

TISA lays extreme significance to practice & learn pedagogy and thus has fully-equipped and brightly lit laboratories for Biology, Physics and Chemistry with equipment and specimens to meet the needs of young learners.

Mathematics Laboratory

A collaborative activity with multiple teaching and learning aids in a separate Mathematics Laboratory to help students understand, explore and analyse mathematical concepts.

A facility to learn a new foreign language is provided to all students of TISA. French and German language other than English are also taken up at TISA which expands the students' cultural awareness and widens the post school study options.
